

Num 11: God sends quail, like he did in Ex 16. but Moses wonders how God will give them meat?

(ESV STUDY BIBLE)

[Num. 11:31–34](#) Quail (small partridges) migrate north across the Sinai Peninsula in the spring (from their winter habitat in Africa) and return in the fall, so although the Israelites had eaten some in the previous year ([Ex. 16:13](#)), these were not a regular dish. The migration of the second year was such that the Israelites were able to catch enormous quantities of quail.

I guess even Moses had bad days of tiredness and doubt despite having seen God's doing things in the past. Note though that Moses speaks as a godly man in despair not in hardened unbelief as the Israelites do.
